



Dismissals under scanner! When it comes to dismissals, Tamkeen isn't messing around!



Hotline to report dismissals

Tamkeen says it stands ready to investigate any suspicions and take decisive action, including recovering support amounts or disqualifying violators from future benefits. Affected individuals are encouraged to contact Tamkeen through a dedicated hotline meant for handling grievances related to dismissals or other arbitrary situations.

"A media campaign will be initiated to encourage affected individuals to report dismissal cases through Tamkeen's dedicated hotline, the statement reads.

Tamkeen also said it will evaluate the existence of a family relationship between the employee and the employer's establishment before any approvals. "Approval or denial of the application will be based on this information," the statement stressed.

HISTORY


THMC was created in the early 1940s to strengthen the community and provide a platform for businessmen to address the various challenges facing them.
